BOOKING CONDITIONS

MAKING YOUR BOOKING

To confirm your booking:

- Complete the booking form and return it with a non-refundable deposit of 25% of the tour price per person.

If booking within 8 weeks of departure, the full tour cost is payable at the time of booking.

Once we receive your booking form and deposit, we will confirm your booking in writing. Approximately 8 weeks before departure, we will issue a final invoice and provide further tour information. Payment is due within 10 days of the invoice date. Late payment may result in cancellation and the application of cancellation charges.

Your travel documents and tour book will be dispatched approximately 7–10 days before departure.

CANCELLATION BY YOU

You may cancel your booking at any time, provided the cancellation is made in writing by the person who signed the booking form.

Cancellation charges:

- More than 60 days before departure: Deposit only (25%)
- 60 to 45 days before departure: 50% of tour cost
- 44 to 29 days before departure: 75% of tour cost
- 28 days or fewer before departure: 100% of tour cost

You may transfer your booking to another person who meets the tour requirements, provided reasonable notice is given. A transfer fee may apply to cover admin costs.

If unavoidable and extraordinary circumstances occur at the destination (e.g. natural disasters, serious health risks), you may cancel without penalty under Regulation 12.

AMENDMENTS OR CANCELLATION BY US

Classic Travelling Ltd reserves the right to cancel or amend tours in exceptional circumstances.

- Minimum numbers: Group tours require a minimum number of cars to operate. If this is not met, we may cancel the tour and offer either an alternative or a full refund.
- Price changes: If unavoidable costs (e.g. currency fluctuations) increase the tour price by more than 2%, we may apply a supplement. You will be notified in advance and may choose to accept or cancel with a full refund.
- Itinerary changes: We reserve the right to adjust the itinerary when necessary, while maintaining the overall quality and experience of the tour.

PASSPORTS, VISAS & HEALTH

It is your responsibility to ensure that:

- Your passport is valid for at least six months beyond the tour dates.
- You obtain any necessary visas.
- You comply with health regulations for all countries visited.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Your policy must include:

- Cancellation cover
- Emergency medical treatment
- Emergency repatriation

Failure to obtain suitable insurance may result in termination of your booking.

TOUR CONDUCT

The tour leader has the authority to disqualify any participant if:

- Medical advice indicates it is necessary for their well-being.
- Their behaviour significantly disrupts the enjoyment or safety of the group.

Any reimbursement for unused portions of the tour will be at the discretion of the Director of Classic Travelling Ltd and the tour leader.

OUR RESPONSIBILITY & ASSISTANCE

We accept responsibility for ensuring that the tour is delivered as described and to a reasonable standard.

We do not exclude or limit liability for death, injury, or illness caused by proven negligence of Classic Travelling Ltd or its employees, agents, or suppliers.

- All claims are subject to English law and jurisdiction.
- Liability is limited where international conventions (e.g. for sea carriers) apply.
- We are not liable for events beyond our control (e.g. war, strikes, terrorism, natural disasters).

If you are in difficulty during the tour, we will provide appropriate assistance, such as helping with alternative arrangements or communication with local authorities.
